- Remember to bring the necessary materials to the exam

### **Complete Your License Application**

 Complete and submit the Salesperson License Application or Broker License Application within one year of passing the exam

 Submit application, fingerprinting card, fees, and other required documents via mail or fax

### Choose an Agency or Brokerage

 Consider where you want to live, average listing and sales prices in various markets, mentorship opportunities, etc.
