STAGE 1: PREPARING FOR TURNOVER

Notify current tenant

- Send a formal notice to the current tenant about the lease end date and move-out requirements.
- Provide move-out instructions and expectations for returning the apartment in good condition.

Schedule turnover date

- Coordinate with the current tenant to determine the exact turnover date.
- Align with maintenance and cleaning teams.
- Conduct pre-turnover inspection
 - Assess the condition of the apartment before the tenant moves out.
 - Identify any damage or maintenance issues that need attention during turnover.

STAGE 2: TENANT MOVE-OUT

Move-out inspection

- Conduct a move-out inspection with the departing tenant to document any damage or issues.
- Discuss any potential deductions from the security deposit based on findings.
- Key collection
 - Collect all keys, access cards, and garage remotes from the departing tenant.
- Tenant communication
 - Inform the tenant of the security deposit refund process and timeline.
- STAGE 3: CLEANING & REPAIRS

General cleaning

Flooring

- Inspect the flooring for any damage or stains.

Plumbing and electrical

- Test electrical outlets and switches, replacing any faulty components.



STAGE 4: SAFETY & FUNCTIONALITY CHECKS

Smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors

- Test and replace batteries in smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors.
- Ensure all devices are functioning correctly.

HVAC system

- Inspect and clean heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems.
- Replace air filters and address any HVAC issues.

Security measures

- Check locks, deadbolts, and doorbells for proper operation.
- Ensure all entry points are secure.

STAGE 5: FINISHING TOUCHES

- Deep cleaning and sanitization
 - Disinfect high-touch surfaces, including doorknobs, light switches, and countertops.
 - Clean and sanitize bathroom and kitchen areas thoroughly.

Window treatments

- Ensure curtains or blinds are in good condition and working properly.
