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# Florida State Legal Requirements

- At least 18 years old
- High school diploma or GED
- US citizen or lawfully admitted resident

**Criminal Record:** For eligibility, you must apply with the DBPR. Certain felony crimes are disqualified.

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## Complete Prelicensing Coursework

- 63 hours
- Florida bar members are exempt from coursework
- People with four-year degrees in real estate may be exempt.

Reciprocity: Florida has mutual recognition with AL, AR, CT, GA, IL, KY, MS, NE, and RI.

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# Get Fingerprints & Background Check

- Between \$50 and \$80, depending on provider
- Need to be completed five days prior to sending your license application

<u>LiveScan</u> or providers approved by the <u>Florida Department of</u> <u>Law Enforcement</u>

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#### **Apply for Your License**

#### Requirements:

- <u>DBPR application portal</u> or <u>paper application</u>
- \$83.75 fee
- Passing exam score
- Certificate of completion
   from real estate education

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#### Take the Real Estate Exam

- Multiple-choice
- 100 questions: 45 national,
  45 state-specific, 10 math)
- 3.5-hour time limit
- \$36.75 fee
